Kitchen Dish Towels

"I love my dish towels so much I forgot I was doing housework!"

Materials needed:

Toweling~ 25 " per towel

Binding ~One - 2" x 42" strips of 30's fabric

Ric Rack:~1 yard of medium or jumbo Ric Rack

Fray Check

Embroidery Floss: Red

Needle

You can purchase toweling at www.quilttaffy.com or kits with all the materials needed to make these dish towels. Our toweling is already 'finished' on the long edges.

With your strip of binding, cut it to toweling width. Our toweling is 16". Sub cut $2 - 16 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. On each side of strip, press 1/4 " to the wrong side.



Then press it in half, to the wrong side.

It's now ready to be sewn to the top and bottom of toweling. Fit your binding to the raw edge of toweling. We sewed 1/8" around the binding to attach it and give it a finished look.

Cut your Ric Rack to the same width size of your toweling plus about an inch. Measure an inch above the binding and draw a horizontal line in pencil. Center your Ric Rack on this line and stitch to attach. Turn under the edges of Ric Rack on the sides. Apply Fray Check.

Find a sunny window, tape words~ Kitchen, Dish or Towel to the sunny window. Trace on toweling with a water soluble pen or light pencil. With embroidery floss back-stitch or stem stitch words.
